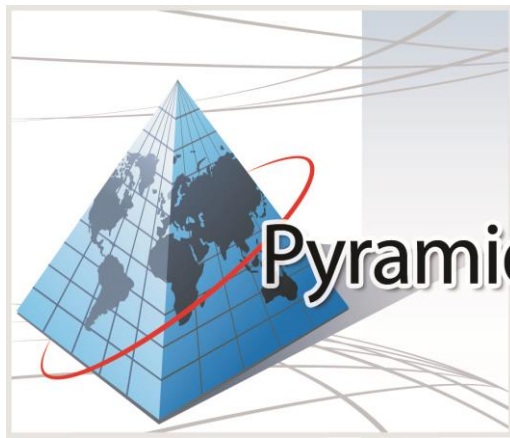

You will receive a certificate of attendance on the night. This will contribute to your CPD and also specific units within your qualification if you are studying with us.

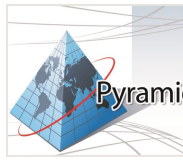

Get More from Your Training Course

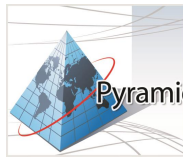
Following these simple guidelines will help you ensure everyone attending our training courses benefits fully.

- Tolerate views that may be alien to your values and counter them diplomatically

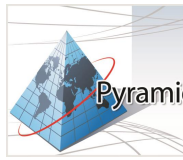
In order to make the most of this training event it is essential that you discuss with your line manager the aims and objectives and the benefit that you hope to achieve.

After you attend the learning event you should ensure you have a follow up discussion with your line manager to discuss the outcomes of your attendance and any learning that can be incorporated into your working life.

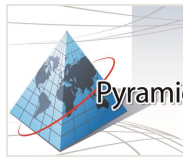
